### Reflexive pronouns :

1. We use a reflexive pronoun after the verb as a **direct object** when the object is **the same as the subject** of the verb:

*I am teaching **myself** to play the piano.*

*Be careful with that knife. **You** might cut **yourself**.*

2. We use reflexive pronouns to talk about the subject of a sentence when we want to emphasize who did the action. The reflexive pronoun usually goes after the object.

I baked the cake myself. (No one else did)



Subject Pronouns	Reflexive Pronouns
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I	myself
you	yourself
he	himself
she	herself
it	itself
we	ourselves
you (plural)	yourselves
they	themselves
